Daniel's Article

"¹⁶For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. ¹⁷For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him." John 3:16-17

The Greatest Statement Ever Written

The Bible contains massively important statements throughout its pages. However, there are a few statements which so transcend time and space, that so capture the divine heart and mind, that so communicate the weighty, exalting work of God in His Son Jesus Christ that life itself stops in the wake of it. Is this the greatest statement ever written? Clearly such a claim would be challenged by many. Some may even respond with an immediate, "what about the verse that says..." To claim one statement by God is greater than another is problematic. The Bible does not claim that this verse is greater than any other verse, but its significance comes from the impact that this one verse has made in the history of the church. This verse, more than any other verse in the scripture has driven evangelism and missions. Often in translation work, as the Bible penetrates a new culture and language, the first verse selected for translation is John 3:16. It dominates the Gospel Tract industry, where many of those booklets contain some or even much of the Roman Road. All Gospel tracts contain John 3:16. All Scripture memory programs for children contain this verse. It is often the first verse a child ever memorizes. It is prominent in our AWANA Program. For me, I remember the day I could quote it. This day stands out more than the day I learned to ride a bike or memorized the multiplication tables. Memorizing this one verse was hugely important within my home and within my childhood church. Even in childhood, I knew there was something about this statement. Somehow this verse captures the essence of the story of God. In such a few words, this message seems to summarize the whole force of divine history.

Here is how Max Lucado describes this verse. "A twenty-six-word parade of hope: beginning with God, ending with life, and urging us to do the same. Brief enough to write on a napkin or memorize in a moment, yet solid enough to weather two thousand years of storms and questions. If you know nothing of the Bible, start here. If you know everything in the Bible, return here. We all need the reminder. The heart of the human problem is the heart of the human. And God's treatment is prescribed in John 3:16

He loves. He gave. We believe. We live.

The words are to Scripture what the Mississippi River is to America – an entryway into the heartland. Believe or dismiss them, embrace or reject them, any serious consideration of Christ must include them...Could you ponder the words of Christ and never immerse yourself into John 3:16? The verse is an alphabet of grace, a table of contents to the Christian hope, each word a safe-deposit box of jewels. Read it again, slowly and aloud, and note the word that catches your attention. 'For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life." We begin a new year with an ancient message. We start 2017 with a reminder of the very essence of our life. God's love mediated through His Son gives us everlasting hope. May this message sustain us all year long.
