Have This Attitude

“5Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, 6who, although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, 7but emptied Himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men, 8Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. 9For this reason also, God highly exalted Him, and bestowed on Him the name which is above every name, 10so that at the name of Jesus EVERY KNEE WILL BOW, of those who are in heaven and on earth and under the earth, 11and that every tongue will confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.” Philippians 2:5-11

Our attitude makes a huge difference in our walk with God, our relationship with our family and friends, and our relationship with our co-workers and fellow church members. Paul longs for the church at Philippi to get along. The attitude of each member factors into the overall unity of the church. He opens this spectacular Christological hymn with a command. “You must have this attitude in yourself!” Often, when we struggle in our relationships with others, it is because we think too highly of ourselves and too lowly of others. From command to example, Paul moves the discussion immediately to the life of Christ. Consider Christ. Consider how great He is. He did not view His equality with God as something He had to cling to. He so completely comfortable in His relationship with the Father that He willingly “emptied Himself.” That is to say, that Jesus set aside all of His divine prerogatives. He temporarily embraced a humble, human life, the life of a servant. In His life, He obediently served His Father and humanity to the point of dying on a cross, the most humiliating death possible. Because of His faithfulness, God the Father bestowed upon Him a title that every person in heaven and on earth will ascribe to Him, “Jesus Christ is LORD!” Christ willing set aside glory in this life in order to maximize His glory in eternity.

Now back to our attitude issues. We are to follow the attitude of Christ. If Jesus Christ can temporarily humble Himself for the sake of God the Father and for us, we too must embrace a life of humble service. When we are arrogant or neglectful in our service of others, then our attitudes betray us. In those moments, we are ignorantly denying the humility and the greatness of God’s Son. We need an attitude adjustment. We must embrace humility as Jesus did. We must serve others as Jesus did. We must willingly lay down our life as Jesus did. God will exalt us to our proper place when the time is right. He has done just that already by exalting His Son to the highest place over all creation. He is the rightful sovereign over the entire universe and we will reign with Him. Our temporary time of humble service will be rewarded with everlasting joy in His presence.


40 Days of Prayer & Events

TEXAS IS A MISSION FIELD

There are still millions who have never heard the living message of Jesus. Others have heard and rejected the message. Whether in the growing metropolitan cities or the rural counties of the state, Texas Baptists are to make Christ known. The task is large but when we are TOGETHER . . . In 1910, the first State Missions Week in Texas was established under the leadership of Mary Hill Davis, president of Woman's Missionary Union of Texas (WMU).

In 1935, the state missions offering was named the Mary Hill Davis Offering for Texas Missions in memory of one who faithfully served the cause of missions for throughout her life. Since then the Week of Prayer for Texas Missions and the Mary Hill Davis Offering® (MHDO) has been a way to challenge and engage Texas Baptists to pray, give, and go.

In a world with so many religions, why Jesus?

We are living in a time when you can believe anything, as long as you do not claim it to be true. In the name of “tolerance,” our postmodern culture embraces everything from Eastern mysticism to New Age spirituality. But as Ravi Zacharias points out, such unquestioning acceptance of all things spiritual is absurd. All religions, plainly and simply, cannot be true.

Jesus Among Other Gods provides the answers to the most fundamental claims about Christianity, such as:

Aren't all religions fundamentally the same?


Was Jesus who He claimed to be? Can one study the life of Christ and demonstrate conclusively that He was and is the way, the truth, and the life?

In each chapter, Zacharias considers a unique claim that Jesus made and then contrasts the truth of Jesus with the founders of Islam, Hinduism, and Buddhism with compelling insight and passionate conviction. In addition to an impressive breadth of reading and study, he shares his personal journey from despair and meaninglessness to his discovery that Jesus is who He said He is.
