The Relational Aspect of Our Faith

"I am the true vine, and My Father is the vinedresser. ² Every branch in Me that does not bear fruit, He takes away; and every branch that bears fruit, He prunes it so that it may bear more fruit. ³ You are already clean because of the word which I have spoken to you. ⁴ Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me. ⁵ I am the vine, you are the branches; he who abides in Me and I in him, he bears much fruit, for apart from Me you can do nothing. ⁶ If anyone does not abide in Me, he is thrown away as a branch and dries up; and they gather them, and cast them into the fire and they are burned. ⁷ If you abide in Me, and My words abide in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be done for you. ⁸ My Father is glorified by this, that you bear much fruit, and so prove to be My disciples." John 15:1-8

Jesus says to us, "abide in Me." The Christian life is fundamentally a life of relationships, primarily a relationship with God and secondarily a relationship with each other. The word "abide" has a certain richness to it. It speaks to the type of daily activities for those in close relationships. Currently there are seven people abiding in our home. The evidence of the rather large "abiding" pervades the house. Six of the seven are driving age. Sometimes just to get a car out of the driveway involves multiple moves, like some strange game of auto chess. The doorway is always stacked with items that have just come in from one of the cars or items that need to be transported somewhere else in fulfilling the day's task for one of the inhabitants of our home. Laundry and dishes provide a constant stream of work. When the two dogs and two cats are included in this mix, the drama grows even more. We live together. At times we eat together, laugh together, make messes together and even argue together. The relationships within the home are always an aspect of even the simplest tasks. As a family we abide together. There is rarely a waking moment when the reminders of the relational aspect of our home are not on display. When Jesus chose this word, "abide," He did so with the intent of capturing the constant, relational aspect of a life of following Him. We are to abide in Him. The way a branch depends on the vine, we must depend on Christ. We must pursue a constant relationship with Him as He pursues a relationship with us. We need Him and He pursues us out of our need for Him.

The Practical Aspects of Our Faith

There are also practical aspects of our faith. "Abide in Me, and I in you. As the branch cannot bear fruit of itself unless it abides in the vine, so neither can you unless you abide in Me." The relationship produces something. When we abide in Christ there is evidence. Just as there is evidence at our home of a regular and large gathering of family, there must be evidence of our relationship with Christ. The evidence of this relationship must be on display in our lives, in all aspects of our lives. We alter the way we wake in the morning because we abide in Him. We change the way we go to bed at night because we abide in Him. We speak and eat, play and work, love and disdain, with His abiding presence constantly pressing our choices. The fruit we bear is a transformed life that impacts our own approach to daily tasks but also positively impacts others around us. We are to bear fruit out of our relationship with Christ. We cannot bear fruit apart from Him. We also cannot abide in Him without bearing fruit. The relationship leads to transformation. Transformation comes only from the relationship. This are defining attributes of the Christian life, relationship and transformation.







Just a reminder: Daylight Savings Time begins March 11th, so please remember to turn those clocks forward!






